

Reconnecting Your D2L Brightspace Integration

Action required: A recent update to the P&SS platform has changed the permission scope used for the D2L Brightspace integration. As a result, your integration may now show as Disconnected. Please follow the steps below to reconnect it — this only needs to be done once.

Before you start, make sure you have:

- Admin access to your P&SS account
- Admin access to your D2L Brightspace site (specifically the Manage Extensibility area)
- About 10 minutes

Step-by-Step Guide

Part 1 — Copy the new scope from Planning & Self Study

Step 1: Check the integration status in P&SS

Log in to P&SS as an administrator. Go to your LMS Integrations page. You'll see the D2L integration listed with a status of Disconnected.

Step 2: Click "Reconnect"

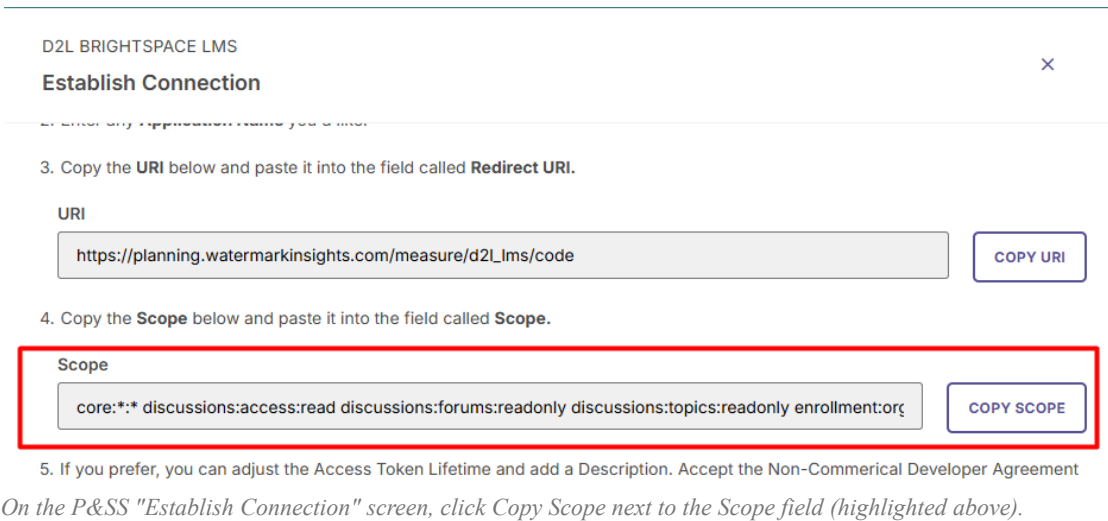
Click the Reconnect button next to the D2L integration. This opens the D2L integration setup page.

Click the  menu on the D2L Brightspace LMS card, then select Reconnect (not Review Mappings).

Step 3: Copy the new scope value

On the setup page, you'll see a field containing the new OAuth 2.0 scope. Copy this value — you'll paste it into D2L in the next part. Keep this browser tab or window open.

3. Copy the **URI** below and paste it into the field called **Redirect URI**.

4. Copy the **Scope** below and paste it into the field called **Scope**.

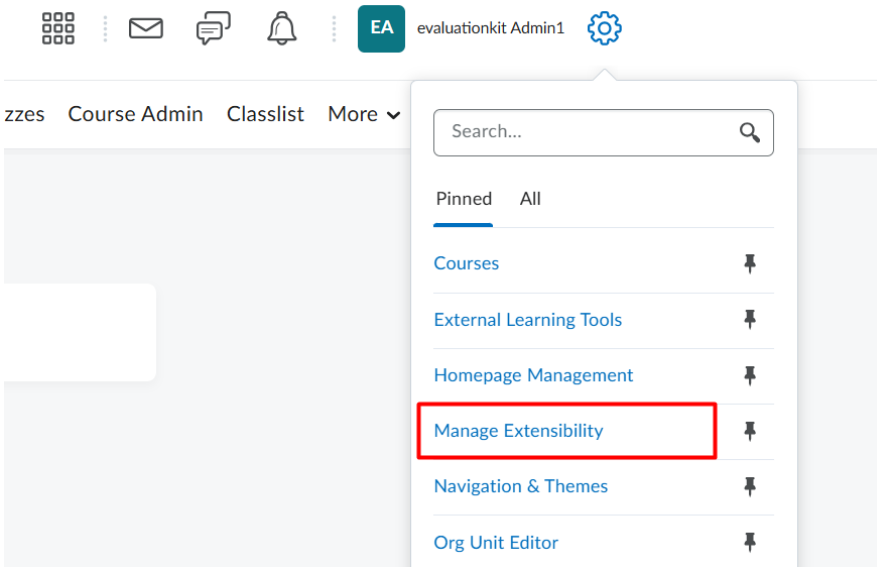
5. If you prefer, you can adjust the Access Token Lifetime and add a Description. Accept the Non-Commerical Developer Agreement

On the P&SS "Establish Connection" screen, click Copy Scope next to the Scope field (highlighted above).

Part 2 — Update the scope in D2L Brightspace

Step 4: Go to Manage Extensibility

In a new tab, log in to D2L Brightspace as an administrator and navigate to Manage Extensibility.



Click the gear (Admin Tools) icon, then select Manage Extensibility from the menu.

Step 5: Open the OAuth 2.0 tab

Within Manage Extensibility, select the OAuth 2.0 tab. Locate the application that was originally created to connect D2L with P&SS.

On the OAuth 2.0 tab, find your institution's P&SS application in the list (application names vary by institution).

Step 6: Open the app for editing

Click on that OAuth 2.0 application, then click Edit.

Step 7: Replace the scope

In the Scope field, remove the existing scope value entirely, then paste in the new scope you copied from P&SS in Step 3.

In the app's Edit screen, clear the Scope field and paste in the new value from Step 3 (highlighted above).

Step 8: Save your changes

Click Save to update the OAuth 2.0 application with the new scope.

Part 3 — Reauthorize in P&SS

Step 9: Return to P&SS

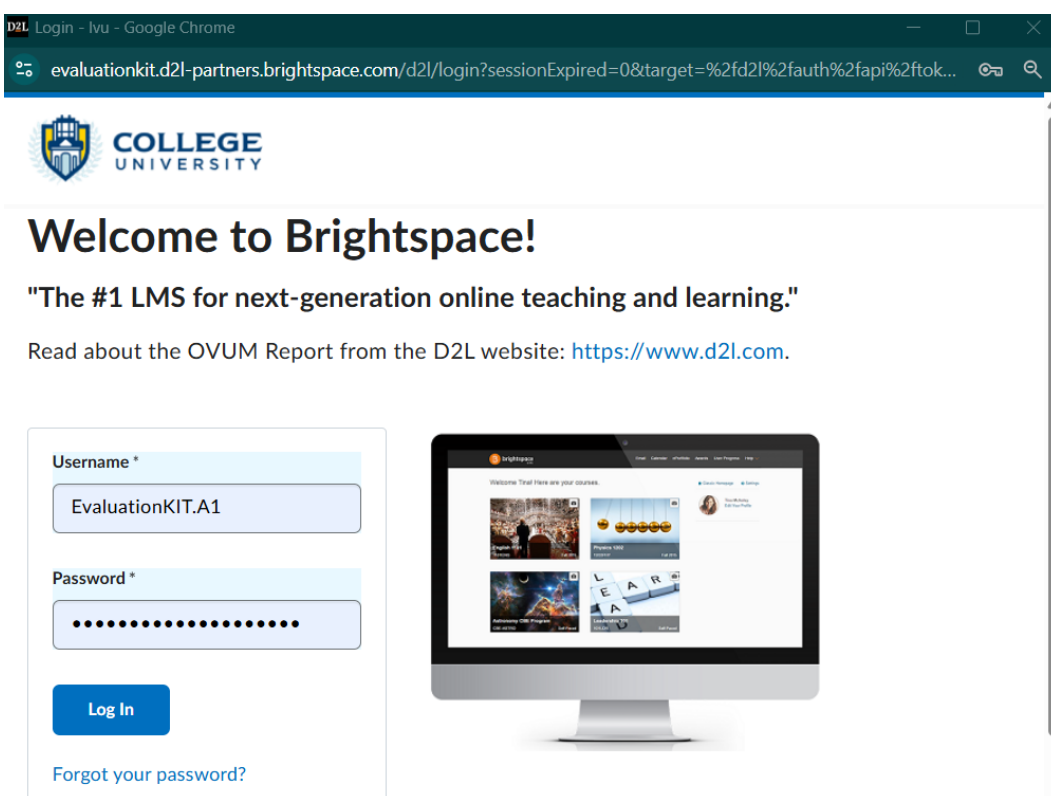
Switch back to the P&SS browser tab from Part 1.

Step 10: Click "Authorize"

Click the Authorize button to begin reconnecting the integration.

Step 11: Log in with your D2L credentials

When prompted, sign in with your D2L Brightspace administrator credentials to complete authentication.



A D2L Brightspace login window opens — enter your D2L administrator username and password, then click Log In.

Step 12: Confirm the integration is connected

Once authentication completes, the D2L integration status in P&SS will change back to Connected. No further action is needed.
